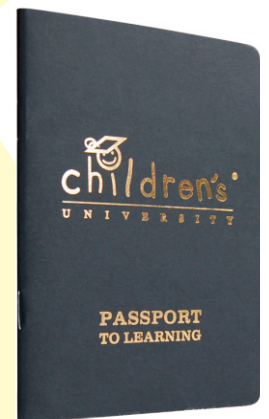


How do I collect my hours?

Make sure that you fill in your passport for every Children's University Learning Destination that you go to. Your activity leader will give you a stamp or a sticker for your passport to show that you have been. Your first 30 hours (Bronze Award) can be in one or more activities but after that you should have at least 5 hours of something new to get your Silver Award and then 10 hours of something new for all awards from then on.

What is the back section for?

In the back section of your passport you can collect stamps and stickers for activities that you have taken part in which are not part of the Children's University™. This might be your school homework club, a trip out or a special award.

These stickers will not count towards your hours of learning.
