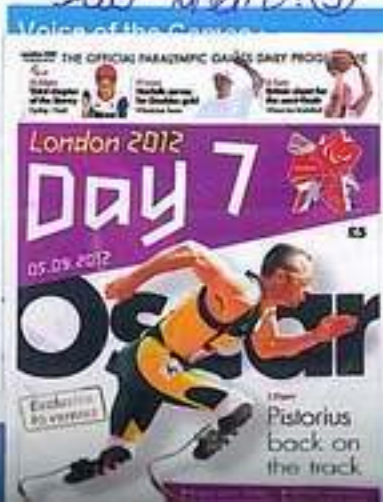
Wednesday 5th September 2012
