Can you grow your own cress?

- 1. Wet some kitchen roll and put it in the bottom of an empty yoghurt pot, then wet some cotton wool and place on top of the kitchen roll.
- 2. Leave a 3cm gap under the top of the pot, then sprinkle in a teaspoon of cress seeds and press down gently with your finger.
- 3. Place the cress heads in a warm place exposed to daylight and wait for your seeds to grow.
- 4. Use your cress to make a delicious sandwich! Don't forget to take a picture! You can tweet it to us @CUYork.

★ What do you think this street would have been used for in the past? Can you spot anything that would help you to find out?




Discover York Minster!
