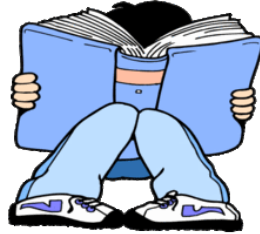


Library Treasure Hunt

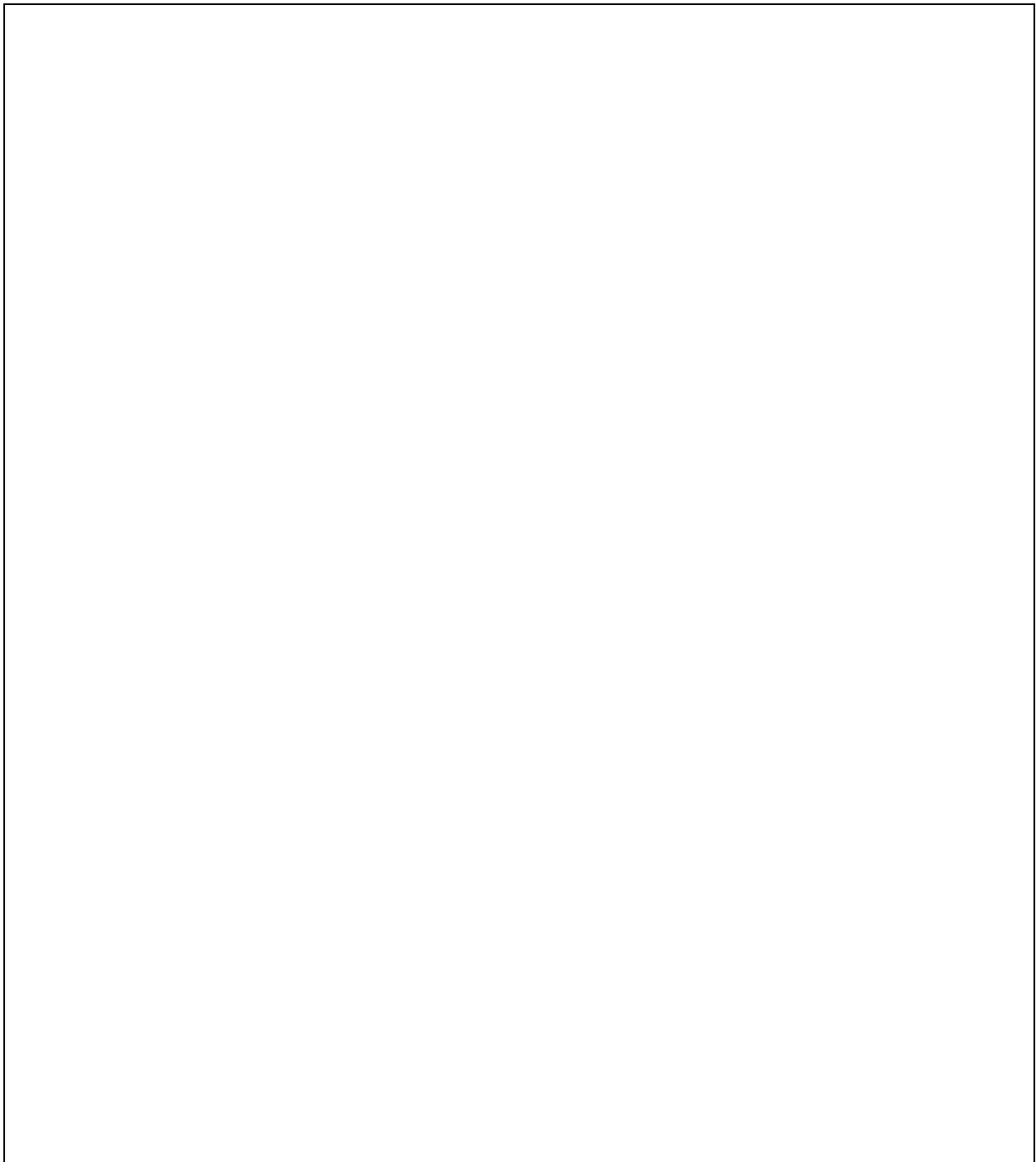

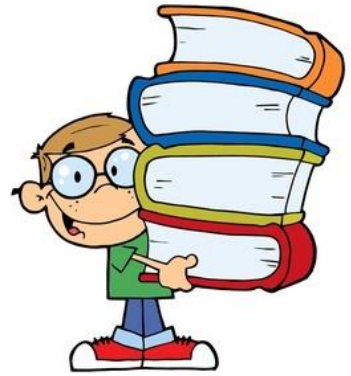
